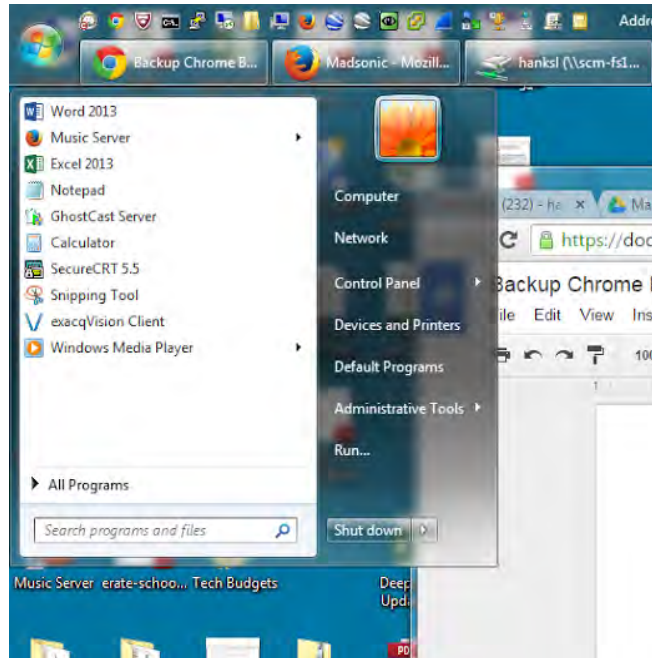


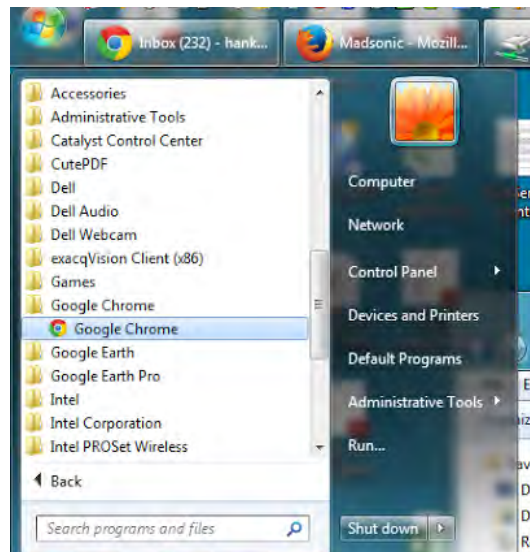
Save Bookmarks In Google Chrome Browser

This tutorial will walk you through the process of exporting your saved bookmarks that are in Google Chrome. This will allow you to save a copy of these bookmarks to import (reinstall) on a new computer.

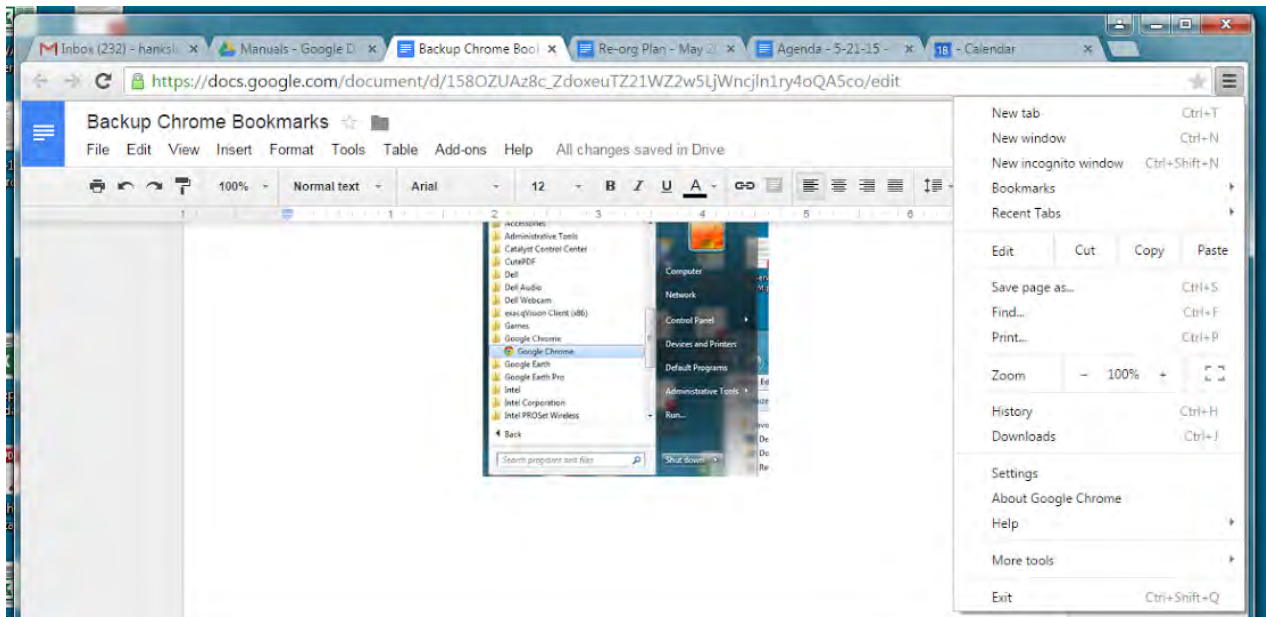
1. Click on the Start Menu button to open it.



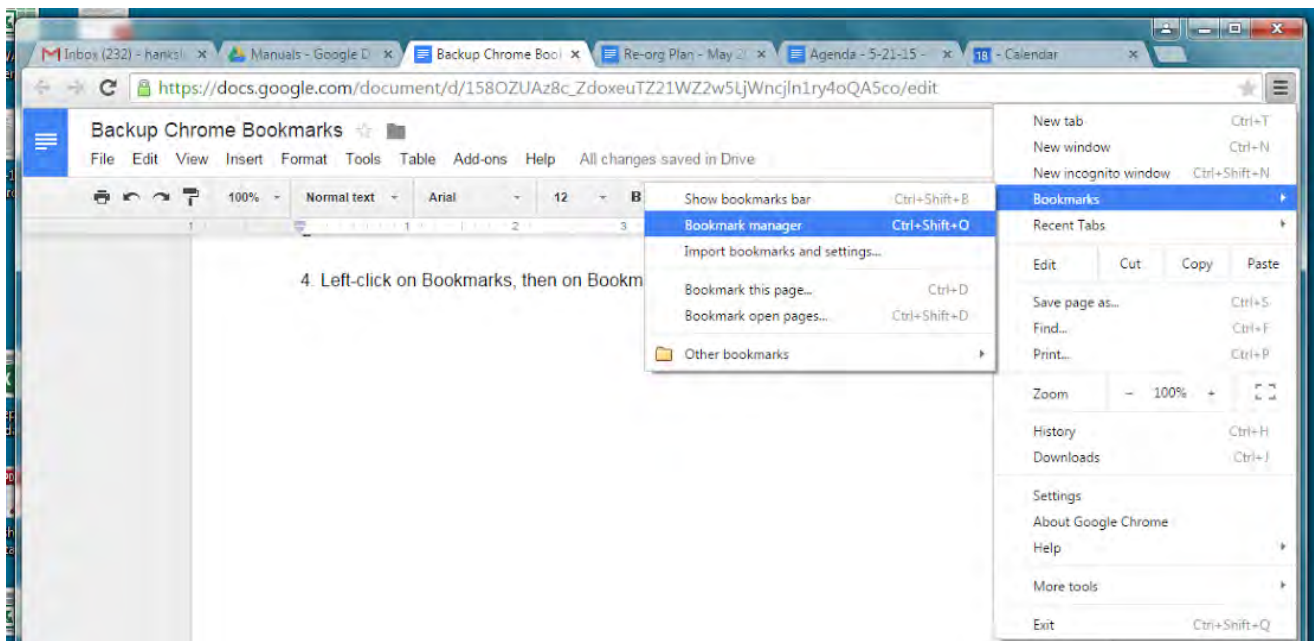
2. Click on "All Programs", look for Google Chrome and left-click on it to open.



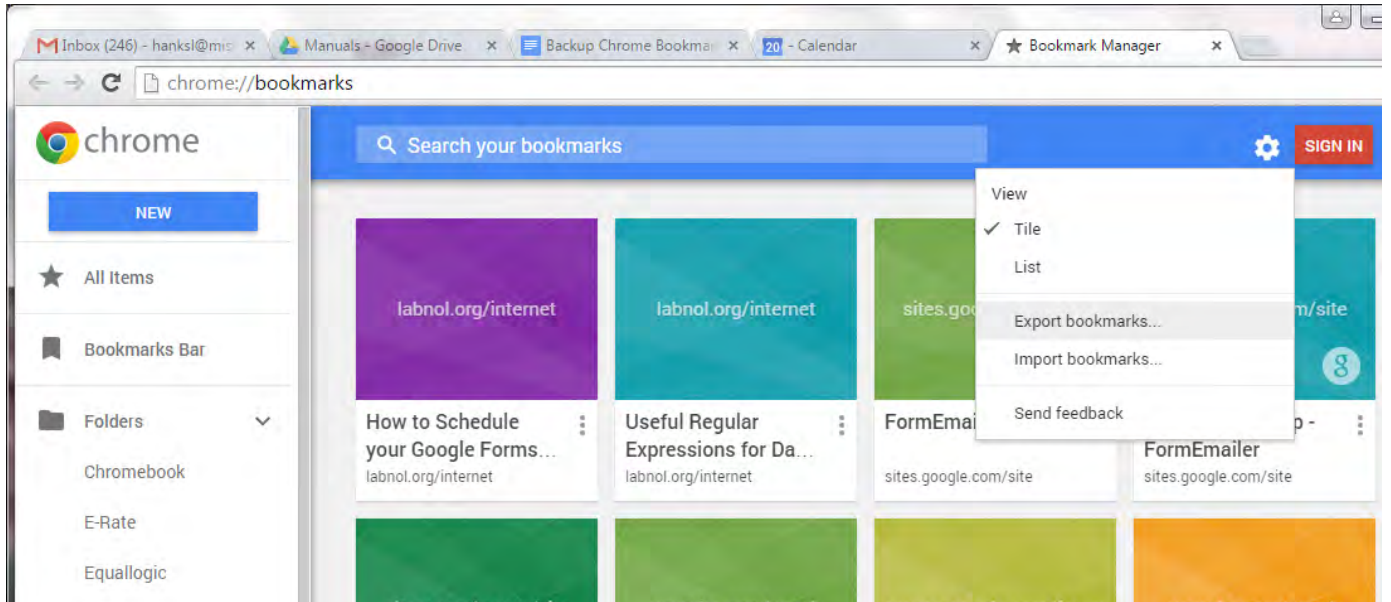
3. Once Google Chrome opens, left-click on the three lines that are on the top right.



4. Left-click on Bookmarks, then on Bookmark Manager.



5. The next tab that opens within Chrome is the Bookmark Manager. Click on the gear icon on the top right and select, "Export Bookmarks".



6. Change the saved location to be your home directory. It is the network drive that has your name on it. Finally, click save on the bottom right of the window. Your bookmarks have now been saved from the Google Chrome browser.
